## 2 Introduction

Edukado's vision is to inspire and be inspired towards sustainable development, with a focus on education.

To make this happen, Edukado annually supports a project by "donating" a structure that is important for the continuation or expansion of that non-profit organisation's project. The organisation chosen by Edukado benefits from a collaboration over one academic year during which a group of higher education students raises money. During the summer, they will then erect the building on site in cooperation with the local population. The emphasis on the latter is essential for Edukado, as the organisation's mission implies much more than mere construction. Indeed, we also strive for intercultural exchange, giving our students and locals the opportunity to share their cultures, traditions, beliefs and so much more.

In concrete terms, this means that the construction of the education-related project in question is both a goal to achieve socially sustainable development and, at the same time, a means of making work of global citizenship in this globalised world.

Eligible projects should therefore have some relation to education. Priority will be given to classrooms. Furthermore, the building should not exceed 100m<sup>2</sup> with a budget of approximately EUR 12,000. Note: This budget includes both construction costs as the students' accommodation costs.
